
VENN DIAGRAM ACTIVITY

Using the Venn diagram below identify at least one characteristic in each circle and then identify what is similar in the center of the diagram. After completing the Venn diagram you should use the story starter to write one paragraph describing solders thought of being courageous and in the second paragraph you should write about a soldier's thought about being a coward. In your third paragraph identify the similarities of both characteristics as a soldier is faced with going to war.
